The Department has determined that RDFW is an acceptable water barrier for use in emergencies or other short-term situations. You are free to market these products to the Department's Maintenance employees and its contractors for use during flooding incidents. Applications might also be found with the Department's Design and Construction Divisions (such as temporary cofferdams during construction), but that use is dependent upon the Department's development of a contract specification.
